(Cash or bank guaranteed cheques only). All Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, marked **"CQ 2906/10 127/2020 – CLOSED QUOTE INVITATION: PROPOSAL FOR APPOINTMENT OF A MUNICIPAL AUCTIONEER"**, to be placed in a Closed Quotation Box No. 2 Industria Cresnet Kwadukuza 4450, by no later than 12h00 **6th NOVEMBER 2020**, wherein all Bid Submissions will be opened in public. No Late, electronic or faxed Bids will be accepted.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:

- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution – an original or certified copy of the certificate is required)
- KwaDukuza Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.
- Bidders must complete and sign in full all MBD documents.
- Compliance with Regulation 27(2) of the Supply Chain Regulations.
- Bidders to furnish and attach a National Treasury's Central Supplier Database Number and Summary report.
- Bidders to furnish and attach a SARS PIN Number and the Tax Compliance Status Pin Report.
- Minimum one year of auctioneering experience.
- Two Minimum Reference letters or Contracts.
- A sound Proposal on how the auction will be conducted including Commission percentage charge inclusive of VAT.
- Bidders to furnish Certificate of registration with South African Institute of Auctioneers or any other Professional body.
- Service Providers must attach a copy of the most recent municipal account / utility bill in which the business is registered. District municipality (water) and Local municipality (rates, electricity and other) or if the bidder is a tenant then a letter from the landlord indicating that the levies are not in arrears OR an Affidavit stating that the ward is Exempt from paying Rates. (Failure to comply with these conditions will disqualify bid).
