Late, electronic or faxed Quotes will not be accepted.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:

- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level Of Contribution – an original or certified copy of the certificate is required)
- Council's Supply Chain Management Policy
- Service Providers Shall be registered on the National Treasury's Central Supplier Database
- Prices tendered must be firm and inclusive of VAT
- Service providers to complete and sign in full all MBD documents..
- A copy of the most recent municipal account / utility bill in which the business is registered. District municipality (water) and Local municipality (rates, electricity and other) or if the bidder is a tenant then a letter or certificate from the landlord indicating that the levies are not in arrears OR a letter from the Ward Councillor stating that the specific Ward is exempt from paying rates, electricity and other services or an Affidavit
- Compliance with Regulation 27(2) of the Supply Chain Regulations(Where Brands specified or equivalent will suffice)
- First preference to be given to bidders residing in the KwaDukuza Municipal area of jurisdiction.
- Proof of address by way of municipal utility bill or signed letter by ward councillor must be provided with bid. Failure to submit this proof will invalidate your submission.

All prospective Bidders will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base. Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest quote or any quote and reserves the right to accept any part or the whole of any quote and preference will be given to Affirmable Business Enterprises.
