## APPOINTMENT OF PANEL OF SERVICE PROVIDERS TO SUPPLY SCHOOL UNIFORMS FOR A PERIOD OF SIX (6) MONTHS

In terms of Chapter 11 of the Municipal Finance Management Act No 56 of 2003, tenders are hereby invited for the above.

(Cash only). Tender documents will be available from 10h00 on 24TH November 2022. The cut-off time for selling of tender document is 15h00 on the 5<sup>th</sup> December 2022. A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the LED Building Boardroom, No.42 Hulette street( Old Library), KwaDukuza, starting at 10h00 am on 6<sup>TH</sup> December 2022 . Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting will disqualify the tender. Only those contractors who are in possession of a tender document shall be permitted to attend and participate in discussion at the compulsory clarification meeting. Doors to the venue will be closed at 10H00. NO LATE BIDDERS WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND.

Tenders shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed with **TENDER NO. Tenders are to be submitted on the tender documentation provided by the Municipality. Late, electronic, or faxed tenders will not be accepted.

## Tenders will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria: -

• The bidders will be evaluated on functionality, as follows.

B. References of Similar Work done (in relation to product categories of listed items.	30
C. Logistics and Delivery Plan	25

Note: Detailed evaluation criteria is contained in the document, with clear and unambiguous description of point's allocation.

- The qualifying bidders must obtain a minimum of 60 points in order to be considered for further evaluation.
- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulation. 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution an original or certified copy of the certificate is required).
- Contractor shall be registered on the National Treasury's Central Supplier Database.
- Council's Supply Chain Management Policy and other applicable legislations.
- Prices tendered must be firm and inclusive of VAT.
- Contractor shall provide the Municipality with a compliance clearance PIN to verify your tax compliance status.
- A copy of the most recent municipal account / utility bill (Not older than 3 months) in which the business is registered, District municipality (water) and Local municipality (rates, electricity and other) or if the bidder is a tenant then a letter or certificate from the landlord indicating that the levies are not in arrears OR a letter from the ward councillor or an Affidavit stating that the ward in which the business operates is exempted from paying rates, electricity and water.
- The tender offer validity period will be 90 consecutive days.
- Service Providers to ensure compliance with MBD 6.2 -Local Content (Applicable)

- Only locally produced goods or locally manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold <u>100%</u> for local production and content, will be considered.
- Preference will be given to an EME (exempted micro enterprise) or QSE (qualifying small business enterprise) which is at least 51% owned by black people residing within the jurisdiction of KwaDukuza and suppliers that are stockists of uniforms or approved agents to supply uniforms. A proof of letter from the accredited SUPPLIER / STOCKIST confirming the capacity of the agent to supply and deliver the uniform.

All prospective tenderers will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Database.

Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves the right to accept any part or the whole of any tender. Preference will be given to an EME (exempted micro enterprise) or QSE (qualifying small business enterprise) which is at least 51% owned by black people residing within the jurisdiction of KwaDukuza. The Municipality also reserves the right to call on preferred bidders to form a joint venture with a BEE company.

Canvassing in any form in the gift of Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the tender. No bids will be considered from the persons in the service of any organ state.
