The KwaDukuza Municipality invites tenders for Tender No. **MN 240/2022** – Panel of contractors for the repairs, maintenance and refurbishment of KwaDukuza Municipality electrical MV/LV infrastructure equipment's during and after normal working hours for a period of three (3) years. Only Tenderers who are registered with CIDB in a contractor grading of **4 EP** and higher and emerging contractors with grading **3 EP PE** or higher will be eligible to tender. Tenderers will have proof of CIDB registration by closing date of tender failing which the tender will be disqualified. Tenderers shall be registered on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database

A compulsory clarification meeting, with representatives of the Employer, will take place at the KwaDukuza Municipality: PMU BUILDING-BACK ENTRY OPEN PARKING, Lavoipierre Building 2 Industria Crescent, KwaDukuza, 4450 on 24 January 2023, starting at 10H00. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting will disqualify the tender. Doors to the venue will be closed at 10H00 and the briefing will commence immediately. Late attendance will not be accepted and tenderers will NOT be admitted into the meeting venue. Only those tenderers who bring the original tender document at the clarification meeting shall be permitted to participate in discussion at the compulsory clarification meeting.

Tenders shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed with **MN 240/2022**, and be placed in the Tender Box at the Municipal Offices, No.2 Industria Crescent SCM Building KwaDukuza 4450, KwaDukuza, not later than 12400 on 3 February 2023 at which time the tenders will be opened in public. Tenders are to be submitted on the original tender documentation provided by the Municipality. Late, electronic or faxed tenders will not be accepted

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:

- Functionality scoring with a minimum of 60 points will be considered for further evaluation.
- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution - an original, sworn affidavit signed by EME representative and attested by the commissioner of oath or copy of the BBBEE certificate issued by CIPC is required)
- Council's Supply Chain Management Policy and other applicable legislation.
- Bidders shall provide a copy of a CSD Summary Report as proof of registration.
- Bidders shall provide the Municipality with a Tax Compliance Status PIN.
- NB: Bidders who are listed in the National Treasury register of defaulters and restricted suppliers will be automatically disqualified.
- A copy of Municipal Utility Bill (not older than 3 months) in which the business is registered. Metro, District Municipality and Local municipality or if the bidder is a tenant, then a letter or certificate from the landlord indicating that the applicable rates/levies are not in arrears. Should the above not be applicable, the service provider shall submit an affidavit.
- Bidders with a CIDB Certificate with a grading of 4 EP or higher and emerging contractors with grading 3 EP PE or higher will be eligible to tender.
- Certificate of Attendance at the clarification meeting.
- Compliant with this tender technical specification requirement including submission of relevant documentation.
- Only locally produced goods or locally manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content would be considered: -
 - Electrical and Telecom Cables
- 90%
- Overhead lines hardware

- Failure to complete Local Content MBD6.2 and its annexures will invalidate the Bid.
- Being part of the panel does not guarantee work.
- Contractors will never be awarded work that exceeds their CIDB Grading threshold.

Evaluation for functionality. Only service providers who achieve a minimum of 60 percent score will be considered for further Evaluation process.

Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves the right to accept any part or the whole of any tender. Municipality also reserves the right to call on preferred bidders to form a joint venture with a BEE company. For all tenders awarded exceeding R4m, the Tenderer must sub-contract 45% of the contractable items to an EME or QSE which is at least 51% owned by black people. 1% for all technical projects exceeding R10m must be allocated to skills development program. Canvassing in any form in the gift of Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the tender. No bids will be considered from persons in the services of any organ of state.
