A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the **Supper Room (behind Town Hall) 14 Chief Albert Luthuli Street**, KwaDukuza, on **12th November 2019** starting at **10h00**. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting will disqualify the tender. Doors to the venue will be closed at **10H00** and the briefing will commence immediately. Late attendance will not be accepted, and contractors will not be admitted into the venue. Only those tenderers who are in possession of a tender document shall be permitted to participate in discussion at the compulsory clarification meeting.

Tenderers should be represented at the clarification meeting by a person who is suitably qualified and experienced to comprehend the implications of the work involved.

Tenders shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed with **MN 33/2019**, and be placed in the Tender Box at the Municipal Offices, **14 Chief Albert Luthuli Street**, KwaDukuza, not later than **12h00 on 28 November 2019**, at which time the tenders will be opened in public. Tenders are to be submitted on the tender documentation provided by the Municipality. Late, electronic or faxed tenders will not be accepted.

Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:

- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution - an original or certified copy of the certificate is required)
- Council's Supply Chain Management Policy.
- Contractor shall be registered on the National Treasury's Central Supplier Database.
- Contractor shall provide the Municipality with a compliance clearance PIN to verify your tax compliance status.
- A copy of the most recent municipal account in which the business is registered. District/Local municipality (water) and Local municipality (rates, electricity and other) or if the bidder is a tenant then a letter or certificate from the landlord indicating that the levies are not in arrears.
- **NB: Bidders who are listed in the National Treasury register of defaulters and restricted suppliers will be automatically disqualified.**
- Certificate of Attendance at the clarification meeting.
- Compliant with this tender technical specification requirement including completion and return of the relevant Technical Schedule: **Schedule A to D**.
- Each Item on the Bill of Quantities will be evaluated separately. Bidders can submit bid on any Item.
- The Goods, services, or work to be delivered in terms of the above specified bid must comply with the minimum Local Content requirements of 90% as specified in the bid and as measured in terms of SATS 1286:2011
- Audited Annual Financial Statement for the Past Three Years.
- Original Bank Rating Letter from A Registered Financial Institution for tenders exceeding R4M
- Letter of Intent for Performance Guaranteed.

All prospective tenderers will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base. Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves the right to accept any part or the whole of any tender and preference will be given to Affirmable Business Enterprises. The Municipality also reserves the right to call on preferred bidders to form a joint venture with a BEE company. 1 % of the project value must be allocated to skills development program within KDMs jurisdiction. Canvassing in any form in the gift of Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the tender. No bids will be considered from persons in the services of any organ of state.
