### **T1.1 TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER**

The KwaDukuza Municipality invites tenders for the above. Only Tenderers who are registered with CIDB in a contractor grading of **5 SB or higher and emerging contractors with grading 4 SB PE or higher will be eligible to tender**. Tenderers will have proof of CIDB Registration by closing date failing which the tender will be disqualified. Tenderers shall be registered on National Treasury's Central Supplier Database.

A compulsory clarification meeting, with representatives of the Employer, will take place at the KwaDukuza Municipality: PMU Building, (BACK ENTRANCE) OPEN SPACE YARD COMPLEX, 2 Industria Crescent on **5<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2022, starting at 13h00**. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting will disqualify the tender. Doors to the venue will be closed at **13H00** and the briefing will commence immediately. Late attendance will not be accepted and contractors will not be admitted into the venue. Only those tenderers who are in possession of a tender document shall be permitted to participate in discussion at the compulsory clarification meeting. All bidders need to adhere to COVID19 regulations.

Tenders shall be placed in sealed envelopes, endorsed with **TENDER NO. MN 07/2022 PANEL OF CONTRACTORS FOR ROAD REHABILITATION FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS** and be placed in the Tender Box at the Lavoipierre Building (Stores), **NO.2 Industria Crescent Lavoipierre Building Stores** not later than **12h00 on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2022** at which time the tenders will be opened in public. Tenders are to be submitted on the tender documentation provided by the Municipality. Late, electronic or faxed tenders will not be accepted.

**Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated according to the following criteria:**

- Evaluation criteria would be based on Functionality
- 80/20 preference points system will apply in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 (B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution - an original or certified copy of the certificate is required)
- Council's Supply Chain Management Policy.
- Contractor shall be registered on the National Treasury's Central Supplier Database.
- Contractor having a CIDB grading of **5 SB** or higher, and emerging contractors with grading of **4 SB PE** or higher.
- Contractor shall provide the Municipality with a compliance clearance PIN to verify your tax compliance status.
- Certificate of Attendance at the clarification meeting.
- The employment of local labour shall be sourced within the wards of the KwaDukuza Municipality in terms of EPWP.
- The validity of the Tax Clearance Certificate issued by the South African Revenue Services certifying that the taxes of the bidder are in order will be verified against the information recorded on the Central Supplier Database (CSD)
- A copy of the most recent municipal account / utility bill in which the business is registered. District municipality (water) and Local municipality (rates, electricity and other) or if the bidder is a tenant then a letter or certificate from the landlord indicating that the levies are not in arrears OR a letter from the Ward Councillor or an Affidavit stating that the ward in which the business operates is Exempt from paying rates, electricity and water. **Failure to submit this will lead to your bid being deemed as non-responsive**
- Prices tendered must be firm and inclusive of VAT.
- Original Bank Rating Letter from A Registered Financial Institution for tenders exceeding R4m.
- Subcontracting will apply to all projects exceeding R4m, in line with KwaDukuza SCM policy.
- The validity period is 84 calendar days

## Evaluation Criteria of Proposals

The Evaluation Criteria to be used to evaluate the proposals will be Method 04: Quality, Financial Offer and Preference. Only Service Providers who will achieve a minimum score of 25 points of the Total available Points will qualify for further evaluation.
