

PUBLIC NOTICE

THIS NOTICE SERVES TO INFORM THE PUBLIC OF THE PROHIBITION OF INCINERATING POLISHED/VANISHED COFFINS AND ANY FOREIGN MATERIAL INCLUDING PLASTIC LINERS AND HANDLES.

The community of KwaDukuza including undertakers is informed that Council of KwaDukuza municipality has taken a resolution of banning the incineration of polished/vanished coffins and any foreign material including plastic liners and handles. Therefore, the community is required not to bring to the crematorium coffins that are polished/vanished, that have plastic liners including plastic coffin handles.

The decision is informed by the special condition contained in the Atmospheric Emission License issued to KwaDukuza Municipality in terms of section 41(1)(a) of the National Environmental Management: Air Quality Act, 2004.

The special condition reads as follows: "No incineration of polished/vanished coffins and other foreign materials shall take place, plastic liners including plastic coffin handles must be removed prior to incineration"

NB: The cemetery office will not allow such coffins to go into the furnace, and no one is allowed to force the operator to cremate such coffins.
