Understanding the Municipal Gift and Gratuity Policy

1. Why do municipal employees and councillors declare gifts?

To prevent bribery, corruption, and undue influence.

Gifts, favours, and hospitality from suppliers and contractors can undermine fair, transparent decision-making.

2. What's considered a gift?

- Anything of value from corporate gifts and hampers to meals, tickets, and sponsorships.
- Gifts above R350 are not allowed.
- ♣ Small tokens under R350 must still be declared and recorded.

3. What are the limits?

- No more than three gifts per financial year per official.
- These must not be from the same service provider.
- Any entertainment or event invitations require formal approval

4. Why this matters to the public

It helps ensure your municipality serves **your interests**, not those of **private entities or individuals** offering incentives.
