WHAT IS RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING?

It is a process that compares previous learning of a learner whether it is done formally or informally with experience. In practice, the learners or employees with non-traditional training are assessed against the same unit standards or exit level outcomes of qualifications using the same assessment criteria for learners learning through traditional institutions. KwaDukuza Municipality invites qualifying candidates to participate in the programmes mentioned below:

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicant(s) must be a permanent resident of KwaDukuza.
- At least three years (3) years' experience in construction health and safety in managing the construction site.
- Candidates who own or who are part of an emerging construction company (CIDB Grade 1 -3) based in KwaDukuza LM, will be given first preference.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION

- The applicant must provide company profile with supporting statutory documents, ie. CIDB, SARS & CIPC;
- Curriculum CV of RPL candidate with traceable reference;
- Certified copies of ID, education/training certificate (where applicable) or any reference letter from employer;
- Application letter together with a signed proof of residence letter issued by a Ward Councillor.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 50% and 2% of available opportunities will be allocated to women and people living with disabilities, respectively.
- Successful applicants must be immediately available to participate in the programme
- **No stipend will be offered, as this is not a learnership or intenship programme.**
- Government employees including KwaDukuza municipal workers and also family members of employees and councillors of KwaDukuza are not eligible to apply.
